### Fixes in this Release

- Viewfinder doesn't show full area of capture.
- Web camera displays image upside down when the device is rotated.
- PnP ID for camera configuration.
- Picture not mirrored on front camera.
- Corrupted photos in portrait orientation.
- Default to rear camera on startup only.
- Improved camera flash control.
- User can lose opportunity to add Time/ GPS stamp.
- Low resolution images do not expand to fill available screen resolution.

### What's New in this Release

### Known Issues and Limitations

- Annotations do not scale properly during crop or orientation changes.
- Intermittent rotation anomalies under stress conditions.
- CL900 series will occasionally capture a black image.

### Installation and Configuration Instructions

#### To manually install SnapWorks 1.0.5141.27153, perform the following steps:

1. Download the update and save to the directory location of your choice.
2. Unzip the file to a location on your local drive.
3. Uninstall previous version of SnapWorks prior to installation.
4. Double-click the installer (SnapWorks.msi) and follow the prompts.
5. To configure your platform camera button copy the appropriate registry file to your desktop and double click on it.

#### To silently install SnapWorks 1.0.5141.27153 perform the following steps:

1. Run a command shell as Administrator.
2. Navigate to the directory you placed the SnapWorks msi installer and registry edit files.
6. Run the command `SnapWorks.msi /qb LICENSEFILE=<path>\SnapWorks.lic`
