Installation and Configuration Instructions

To install MC8355 (Gobi3000), perform the following steps:

- 1. Disable Mobile Broadband on the Wireless tab in Motion Dashboard
- 2. Uninstall any previously installed Qualcomm Gobi Single Installer Package through Control Panel → Programs and Features
- 3. Click **download** to save the **MC8355 DriverPkg** to the directory of your choice.
- 4. **Unzip** the file to a location on your local drive.
- 5. Double-click **Setup.exe** and follow the prompts
- 6. Enable Mobile Broadband on the Wireless tab in Motion Dashboard
