<u>NOTE</u>: Prior to installation, ensure that you are currently running an approved version of the Operating System from the table above. Otherwise, visit zebra.com/support and load the correct DCP for your product.

#### Manual Installation:

- 1. Copy "Fusion\_3.40.0.1.065R\_WM65.ARM.CAB" onto the device using Active Sync.
- 2. Click the "Fusion\_3.40.0.1.065R\_WM65.ARM.CAB" to install.
- 3. The device will warm boot and the package installation will take place.

#### Airbeam /Automated Installation:

- 1. Create an Airbeam package that will install "Fusion\_3.40.0.1.065R\_WM65.ARM.CAB".
- 2. Use Airbeam Client to install.
- 3. The device will warm boot and the package installation will take place.

Bugs Fixed:

- SPR 23785 Exception thrown by WLAN firmware intermittently when U-APSD is used.
- SPR 23376 Only when configured for 'Optimize for Cisco' in 5GHz band, the device successfully authenticates (WPA2-Personal), acquires an address and then the radio adapter becomes unavailable.

#### **Fusion 3.40.0.1.057R and prior versions (Some of these versions were part of BSPs)** Bugs Fixed:

- SPR 22009 Memory leak in the Device.exe process slot caused by power cycling the WLAN radio which over time will result in a lockup.
- SPR 22246 WLAN connection dropped when device goes in and out of WAN coverage.
- SPR 22241 Fusion does not connect to the network even when the device is inside the coverage area of an AP. Wireless log shows continuous association timeouts.
- SPR 22327 Once device is connected to WLAN and leaves the WLAN area, the unit still reports that is it connected even though it is not.
